LEGAL DESCRIPTION
FOR PROPOSED
FIRE DISTRICT
(QUILLAYUTE PRAIRIE)

Beginning at the southeast
corner of Government Lot No.
1, Section 1 Twp. 28N., Rge. 14
W., thence southerly along the
east line of Sections 1-12-13
Twp. 28N. RGE. 14 W. to the
south bend of the Bogachiel
River. Thence meandering
westerly along said bank to the
point of intersection with the
north-south section line
between Sections 23-24 Twp. 28
N. Rge. 14 W. Thence southerly
along said line to the east 1/4
corner of Section 23 Twp. 28N.
Rge. 14W. Thence westerly
along the east west center line
of Section 23 Twp. 28N. Rge. 14
W. to the west 1/4 corner of said
section. Thence southerly to the
southwest corner of Section 23
Twp. 28N. Rge. 14W. Thence
westerly to the southwest
corner of Section 22 Twp. 28N.
Rge. 14W. Thence southerly
between Sections 27-28 Twp.
28N Rge 14W. To the southwest
corner of Section 27 Twp. 28N.
Rge. 14W. Thence westerly
along south lines of Sections 28-
29-30 Twp. 28N. Rge 14W and
continuing westerly along south
lines of Sections 25-26 Twp. 28N.
Rge. 15W. To the southwest
corner of Section 26 Twp. 28N.
Rge. 15W. Thence northerly
between Sections 26-27 Twp.
28N. Rge. 15W. to the northwest
corner of Section 26 Twp. 28N.
Rge. 15W. Thence westerly
along the south line of Section
22 Twp. 28N. Rge. 15W. to the
southwest corner of Section 22
Twp. 28N. Rge. 15W. thence
northerly along the west line of
Section 22 Twp. 28N. Rge. 15W.
to the west 1/4 corner of Section
22 Twp. 28N. Rge. 15W. Thence
westerly along east-west center
line of Section 21 Twp. 28N.
Rge. 15W. to the beach of the
Pacific Ocean. Thence
meandering northerly along
said beach to the intersection of
the north line of Section 21 Twp.
28N. Rge. 15W. Thence easterly
along the north line of Section
21 Twp. 28N. Rge. 15W. to the
northeast corner of Section 21
Twp. 28N. Rge. 15W. thence
continuing easterly along the
north lines of Sections 22-23
Twp. 28N. Rge. 15W. to the
northeast corner of Section 23
Twp. 28N Rge. 15 W. Thence
northerly along the west line of
Section 13 Twp. 28N. Rge. 15W.
to the northwest corner of
Section 13 Twp. 28N. Rge. 15W.
Thence easterly along the north
line of Section 13 Twp. 28N Rge.
15W thence running east
between Sections 12 & 13 to the
1/4 corner between Sections 12 &
13 Twp. 28N Rge. 15W. Thence
northerly 1320 feet thence due
east to the line between
Sections 11 & 12 thence
northerly along the east line of
Section 12 Twp. 28N Rge. 15 W.
to the northeast corner of
Section 12 Twp. 28N. Rge. 15W.
Thence easterly along the north
line of Section 7 Twp. 28N. Rge.
14 W. to the northeast corner of
Section 7 Twp. 28N. Rge. 14 W.
thence northerly along the west
line Section 5 Twp. 28N. Rge. 14
W. to the southwest corner of
Government Long No. 4 of
Section 5 Twp. 28 N. Rge. 14W.
Thence easterly along the south
line of Government Lots in
Sections 5-4-3-2 and 1 Twp. 28N.
Rge 14W. to the point of
beginning.
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
